- → Participants join MACS TeleECHO clinic from their own desktop or mobile device using free videoconferencing software.
- ✓ MACS TeleECHO clinic will increase the capacity of prescribers and their practices to implement high-quality addiction treatment through de-identified case presentations, discussions, and recommendations.
